What is this product?


Type: The investment basket, which is an investment product specified by the insurance company, to whose value development the value of the insurance can be tied. The investment basket cannot be acquired separately; it is part of unit-linked insurance. **Objectives**: The objective of the investment basket's investment activities is to achieve, in the medium term, a total return that is as high as possible by investing assets in accordance with the investment basket's rules mostly within the alternative asset class by abiding by the return target set for the investment basket and the investment basket's targeted investment period.

Intended Retail Investor: The investment basket suits investors who are seeking the possible high returns associated with high-risk alternative investments and are ready to take the risk of losing the capital and possible return in part or in full. The investor must have the opportunity to hold on to his or her investments until the termination of the investment basket as the liquidity resulting from the investment basket's investments' asset class is extremely limited. The investor must not be dependent on the liquidity of the investment he or she has made.

Product term: The recommended investment period is 5-8 years. This product's termination takes place as described in the product's rules. The insurance company has a unilateral right to cancel the investment basket without a specific reason by informing the customer of the cancellation within a reasonable amount of time.

What are the risks & what could I get in return?

The risk indicator gives a picture of how this product's risk level relates to the risk level of other products.



The risk indicator assumes you keep the product for 8 years. The actual risk can vary significantly if you cash in at an early stage and you may get back less.

According to PRIIPS regulation, this product's risk level is 3 out of 7, which is a medium-low risk class. The Investment Basket does not have capital protection. The value of investment objects may increase or decrease. The Investment Basket has limited liquidity associated with high-risk

alternative investments and a very high return risk and capital risk. Return risk and capital risk mean that investors may lose the capital that they have invested as well as the returns in part or in full.

The risk-reward profile and risk category of the Investment Basket are subject to change. It is not possible to predict the future development of the fund's risk and reward profile and risk category based on the historical data of the Investment Basket's risk category. Not even the lowest risk category (I) means that the investment is completely risk-free.

What happens if Mandatum Life is unable to pay out?

The product is not covered by the Investors' Compensation Fund or the Deposit Guarantee Fund. The investor may lose all or part of return and the capital he or she has invested in the investment basket. If the insurance company is placed in liquidation or bankruptcy, the interests of the policyholders are secured such that all insurance receivables, regardless of the insurance class and line, hold first preference to all of the company's assets during the company's liquidation and bankruptcy above all other receivables targeted at the company.

What are the costs?

The Reduction in Yield (RIY) shows what impact the total costs you pay will have on the investment return you might get. The total costs take into account one-off, ongoing and incidental costs. The costs that are shown here are the range of cost of this product. The table shows what the costs, including potential exit penalties, could mean for different holding periods. The figures assume you invest 10 000€. The figures shown are partially based on data from the past and therefore may change in the future.

How long should I hold it and can I take money out early?

Required minimum holding period: 8 years

The investment basket is intended for investors who hold on to their investments until the termination of the basket. The basket's termination is described in the basket's rules. If a redemption assignment for the basket's units is presented to the insurance company before the termination date, a redemption fee shall be charged on redemption. It is possible to redeem the investment basket's units twice a year at the value on a value date suitable for redemption. Value dates suitable for redemption are the last day of June and December. The investor can be charged a maximum of 20% of the value of the investment basket unit as a redemption fee, if the investor presents a redemption assignment for the investment basket units prior to the investment basket's termination date. The redemption fee is charged when carrying out the redemption assignment based on the investment basket unit's value.

How can I complain?

The customer can complain about the product, the activities of the product's developer or the party selling the product/providing advice by contacting Mandatum Life either on our Web Service through an online message at the address www.mandatumlife.fi or calling our customer services at tel. $\pm 358\,200\,31100\,(lnc/mnc)$. The complaint can also be made by letter. The feedback will be handled according to current legislation. The processing of the matter will take place without delay, however, within a maximum of 30 days.
