

Authorisation for a guardian or trustee to use Mandatum Life's Web Service

The following rights shall be granted to the authorised person

☐ **Right to view the insurance policies.** The authorised person shall have the right to view the insurance information concerning an underage child or a person under trusteeship in the Web Service.

□ **Right to view and manage the insurance policies.** The authorised person shall have the right to make changes to the insurance, e.g. changing the investment plan for savings insurance in the Web Service.

Terms and conditions of the authorisation

The customer may grant authorisation to use the Web Service, to change the contents of the given authorisations, or to cease the authorisations granted by submitting notification thereof in writing to the Insurance Company.

The Customer grants the authorised user the access right level defined by him or her to the Insurance Company's products and services, according to which the authorised user may carry out transactions in the Insurance Company's Web Service, view the Customer's information and/or make changes that are binding on the Customer and other transactions that can be made in the Web Service.

If the authorised person is the guardian(s) or a trustee of an underage child, the authorisation applies to all insurance policies that can be processed in Mandatum Life's Web Service.

Authorisation pertaining to an underage customer ends when the customer turns 18.

Before an authorised user can use the Web Service, the user must obtain personal identifiers that are approved by the Insurance Company. The Insurance Company shall not be held liable for damage caused to

the Customer or the authorised user due to the authorised user neglecting to comply with the Insurance Company's terms and conditions for using the electronic services.

The Insurance Company shall have the right to decide the access right levels that are in place for the Web Service, as well as how the user rights are established and how they are changed and revoked.

The Customer shall be liable for all actions performed by the authorised user on the Customer's behalf within the limits and during the period of validity of the user rights.

The Customer is obligated to inform the Insurance Company immediately in writing if the Customer wishes to terminate or change the authorised user's user rights. The Customer's responsibility for transactions performed by the authorised user shall end when the Insurance Company has received the notification and has had a reasonable amount of time to enter the information in the Insurance Company's systems.

The Insurance Company's terms and conditions for using the electronic services shall apply alternatively to the service.
